



## COVID-19 STUDENT FACE COVERING EXEMPTION DUE TO MEDICAL CONDITION

In connection with the COVID-19 pandemic and the recent Public Health Order of Constraint (Order No. 2022-1), Granite School District will require students to wear face masks while in attendance in-person at school as required by the aforementioned Public Health Order.

The District recognizes that some students may have medical conditions that make it medically inadvisable or otherwise inappropriate to wear a face mask and accommodations may be needed.

In order to receive an exemption from applicable face covering requirements, **NOTIFY THE SCHOOL IF YOUR CHILD NEEDS THESE EXEMPTIONS PER SLCO COUNCIL CHAIR STATEMENT 1-9-22.**
